NOTIFICATION

No. 7700/SSA2/2000/Home. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 23rd March, 2000.

S. R. O. No. 267/2000.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952 (Central Act 60 of 1952), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following further amendment to their notification No. 9125/SSA2/99/Home dated 24th March, 1999 published as S.R.O. No. 270/99 dated 24th March, 1999 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 621 dated 24th March 1999, appointing a Commission of Inquiry consisting of Sri Justice T. Chandrasekhara Menon, Retired Judge of the High Court of Kerala to enquire into the stampede tragedy in which 52 pilgrims lost their lives and many others sustained injuries at Sabarimala on 14th January 1999 in connection with viewing of "Makarajyothi", namely. -

AMENDMENT

In the said notification, in the 4th para, for the words "within twelve months" the words "within fifteen months" shall be substituted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Government have decided to extend the term of the Commission appointed to enquire into the circumstances which led to the stampede tragedy at Sabarimala temple on 14th January, 1999 in which 52 pilgrims lost their lives and many others injured, for a further period of three months from 24th March, 2000 in continuation of the extension granted as per Notification No. 69726/SSA2/99/Home dated the 26th November, 1999 published as S.R.O. No. 970/99 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 2175 dated the 27th November, 1999.

This notification is intended to achieve the above objective.
