S. R. O. No. 33/2017.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 76 of the Kerala Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1959 (10 of 1960) and in supersession of the notification issued under G. O. (P) No. 9/2016/Law dated 29th August, 2016 and published as S. R. O. No. 578/2016 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1546 dated 2nd September, 2016 Government of Kerala hereby authorise, the levy by the Civil Courts other than Family Courts, tribunals and appellate authorities constituted by or under any special or local law an additional

court fee in respect of original petitions, original applications, appeals or revisions to tribunals, appellate authorities and original suits in Civil Courts other than in Family Court at the rate of one percent of the amount involved in the dispute and in other cases at the rate of rupees one hundred in each such case, subject to section 4A of the said Act and sub-rule (1) of rule 397 of the Kerala Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989. The amount so collected shall be credited to the Kerala Legal Benefit Fund constituted under sub-section (2) of section 76 of the Kerala Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1959.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-section (1) of section 76 of the Kerala Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1959 as amended by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Kerala Finance Act, 2016 (Act 18 of 2016), Government have decided to authorise the levy by the Civil Courts other than Family Courts, tribunals and appellate authorities constituted by or under any special or local law an additional court fee in respect of original petitions, original applications, appeals or revisions to tribunals, appellate authorities and original suits in Civil Courts other than in Family Court at the rate of one percent of the amount involved in the dispute and in other cases at a rate of rupees one hundred in each such case.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
