ഷോപ്പുകളേയും വാണിജ്യസ്ഥാപനങ്ങളെയും സംബന്ധിച്ച 1960-ലെ കേരള ആക്റ്റിലെ (1960-ലെ 34) 29-ാം വകുപ്പിലെ (1എ) ഉപവകുപ്പ് അനുസരിച്ച് 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 13എ, 14, 18, 21, 22 എന്നീ വകുപ്പുകളിലെ ഏതെങ്കിലും വ്യവസ്ഥകൾ ലംഘിക്കുന്ന ഏതൊരാൾക്കും ആദ്യമായി ചെയ്യുന്ന കുറ്റമാണെങ്കിൽ 250 രൂപവരെയാകാവുന്ന പിഴയും രണ്ടാമത്തേതോ അതിനുശേഷമോ ഉള്ള കുറ്റമാണെങ്കിൽ 500 രൂപവരെയാകാവുന്ന പിഴയും ശിക്ഷ നൽകേണ്ടതാണെന്ന് വ്യവസ്ഥ ചെയ്യുന്നു. ഈ ആക്റ്റ് പ്രകാരമുള്ള ഒരു കുറ്റം രണ്ടാമതും ചെയ്യുന്ന ഒരാൾക്ക് തടവുശിക്ഷ നൽകേണ്ടതാണെന്ന് തൊഴിൽവകുപ്പുമന്ത്രി ഒരു കോൺഫറൻസിൽ വച്ച് നിർദ്ദേശിക്കുകയുണ്ടായി. പ്രസ്തുത നിർദ്ദേശം നടപ്പിൽവരുത്തുന്നതിനു വേണ്ടി പ്രസ്തുത ആക്റ്റിൽ ആവശ്യമായ ഭേദഗതി വരുത്തേണ്ടതാണ്.

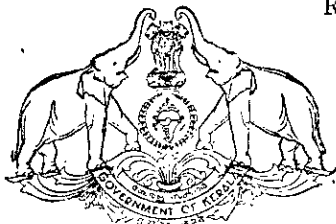

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Rules, 1961, in rule 3, to sub-rule (1), the following provisos shall be added, namely:—

“Provided that the appellate authority may admit an appeal presented after the expiration of the said period, if it is satisfied that the appellant had sufficient cause for not preferring the appeal within the said period:

Provided further that no such appeal shall be admitted after a period of six months from the date of delivery of the order appealed against”.

No. 195/91.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960), the Government of Kerala being satisfied that public interest so requires, hereby exempt the classes of establishments mentioned in the Annexure attached hereto from the provisions of section 9 and section 20 of the said Act for a period of 6 months from the date of publication of this Notification in the Kerala Gazette, subject to the following conditions:—

(1) The period of work of an employee shall be so fixed that, inclusive of his interval for rest, it shall not spread over more than 12 hours in any day.

(2) No young person who has not attained the age of 17 or women shall be required or allowed to work whether as an employee or otherwise before 5 a.m. or after 11 p.m. provided that every such employee who is required to work between 7 p.m. and 11 p.m. and between 5 a.m. and 6 a.m. shall be provided free transport to or from his/her home as the case may be by his/her employer provided she/he resides within 15 Kilometres of the place of work.

(3) The employer shall produce on demand by the Inspector having jurisdiction over the area documents showing classification of his establishment issued by the competent authority.

(4) This exemption shall be deemed to have been revoked if valid complaint to the effect that employees are required or have been allowed to work for more than 8 hours in any day, excluding the number of hours of overtime work permissible and/or persons who have not attained the age of 17 or women employed between 7 p.m. and 11 a.m. and between 5 a.m. and 6 a.m. were not provided free transport to or from his/her house as the case may be provided he or she was residing within 15 Kilometres of her place of work is received by the Government.

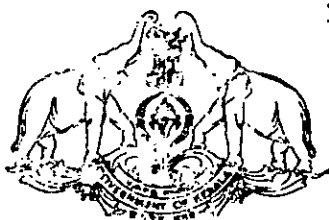

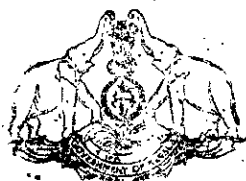

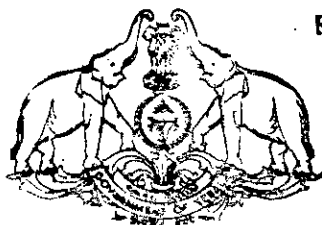

NOTIFICATION

G.O. (Rt.) No. 2906/93/LBR. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 18th November, 1993.

S.R.O. No. 1777/93.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 5 of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960) and in supersession of the Notification No. L. Dis. 2186/57/L&LAD dated the 17th April, 1957 published in the Kerala Gazette dated the 23rd April, 1957 and Notification G.O.(Ms.) No. 1410/48/Development Department dated the 20th March, 1948 issued by the Governor of Madras, the Government of Kerala being satisfied that public interest so requires, hereby cancel the exemption granted under the provisions of the Travancore-Cochin Shops and Establishments Act, 1125 (Act IX of 1125) and the Madras Shops and Establishments Act, 1947 (Madras Act XXXVI of 1947) and hereby order that the provisions of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960) shall apply to the following classes of establishments in the former Travancore-Cochin and Malabar areas of the State, namely:—

1. Doctors' consulting rooms,
2. Dispensaries attached to Doctors' consulting rooms; and

3. Nursing homes, hospitals, and other institutions for the treatment or care of the sick, the infirm, the destitute or the mentally unfit.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Notification but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Though the Travancore Cochin Shops and Establishments Act, 1125 and Madras Shops and Establishments Act, 1947 have been repealed by section 36 of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960, by virtue of the proviso to section 36 of the said Act and with the existence of the Notification No. L. Dis. 2186/57/L&LAD dated 17th April 1957 and G. O. (Ms.) No. 1410/48/Development Department dated 20th March, 1948 issued under the Travancore-Cochin Shops and Establishments Act and the Madras Shops and Establishments Act, 1947 respectively, the provisions of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act are at present not applicable to the establishments mentioned in the Notifications. Now, Government consider it necessary in public interest to cancel the exemption and to extend the provisions of the Act to such establishments also. Hence this notification.

S. R. O. No. 1468/90.—Whereas the Government of Kerala are satisfied that public interest so requires that the opening time of the Sundar Talkies, Kallachi P. O., Nadapuram, Vadakara, Kozhikode should be fixed as 12 noon, for the purpose of conducting noon shows ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 10 of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960) the Government of Kerala hereby order that for a period of one year from the date of publication of this notification, the said theatre shall not be opened earlier than 9 a. m. on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays which fall on other days of the week, and 12 noon on all other days or closed on any day later than 2 a.m.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The provisions of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act 1960 (34 of 1960) are applicable to the Cinema Theatres in this State. The Proprietor, Sundar Talkies, Kallachi P. O., Nadapuram, Vadakara has requested Government to issue orders permitting him to conduct noon shows from 12 noon in theatre under his management. Government consider that the request may be allowed for a period of one year from the date of publication of this notification. This notification is to achieve the above object.

THE KERALA SHOPS AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS

(AMENDMENT) BILL, 1986

A

BILL

further to amend the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960.

Preamble.—WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960, for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

BE it enacted in the Thirty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Act may be called the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments (Amendment) Act, 1986.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of section 29.*—In section 29 of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960), for sub-section (1A), the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1A) Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of sections 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 13A, 14, 18, 21 or 22 shall on conviction be punishable for a first offence with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees and for a second or any subsequent offence, with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year or with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees, or with both.”.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Sub-section (1A) of section 29 of Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960), provides that whosoever contravenes any of the provisions of sections 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 13A, 14, 18, 21 and 22 shall on conviction be punishable with fine which for a first offence, may extend to two hundred and fifty rupees and for a second

or any subsequent offence, may extend to five hundred rupees. At a conference held by the Minister for Labour, it was suggested that for a second offence under the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, the punishment of imprisonment should be given. In order to give effect to the said suggestion, it is proposed to amend the said Act suitably.

2. The Bill is intended to achieve the above object.

FINANCIAL MEMORANDUM

The Bill, if enacted and brought into operation, would not involve any expenditure from the Consolidated Fund of the State.
