

(3) The employer shall produce on domand by the Inspector aving jurisdiction over the area documents showing classification of his establishment issued by the competent authority.

(4) This exemption shall be deemed to have been revoked if valid complaint to the effect that employees are required or have been allowed to work for more than 8 hours in any day, excluding the number of hours of overtime work permissible and/or persons who have not attained the age of 17 or women employed between 7 p.ni. and 11 a.m. and between 5 a.m. and 6 a.m. were not provided free transport to or from his/her house cas the case may be provided he or she was residing within 15 Kilometres of her place of work is received by the Government.

As specified in Section 5A of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (Act 34 of 1960) the Government shall notify "competent authority" under the said Section for compliance of the said provision of the Act and Rules made thereunder. As per G.O. (Ms.) 68/87/LBR. dated 9-12-1987 the Assistant Labour Officers Grade II in the Labour Department have been notified as the "competent authority" under Section 5A of the Act and re-fixed their territorial jurisdiction. Delimitation and division of wards of Local Bodies in the State has changed the territorial jurisdiction of Assistant Labour Officers Grade II which lead to an uneven distribution of Establishments in their area. The total strength of Assistant Labour Officers Grade II, at the time of issuance of G. O. (Ms.) 68/87/LBR dated 9-12-1987 was 99 numbers. As per G.O. (Ms.) 28/97/LBR dated 15-3-1997, a new office of the Assistant Labour Officer Grade II, with Sasthamcotta as its headquarters at Kunnathur Taluk in Kollam District as official jurisdiction has been created. It has therefore become necessary to re-fix the jurisdiction of Assistant Labour Officers Grade II to ensure an even distribution of establishments and also to rectify the anomalies noticed in earlier notification. It is also necessary to invest statutory powers under Section 5A of the said Act upon the Assistant Labour Officers Grade II Sasthamcotta and to fix Kunnathur Taluk as the territorial Jurisdiction.





(AMENDMENT) BILL, 1986

A

BILL

further to amend the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960.

Preamble.—WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960, for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

BE it enacted in the Thirty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:--

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments (Amendment) Act, 1986.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 29.—In section 29 of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960), for sub-section (1A), the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:—

"(1A) Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of sections 6. 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 13A, 14, 18, 21 or 22 shall on conviction be punishable for a first offence with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees and for a second or any subsequent offence, with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year or with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees, or with both."

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Sub-section (1A) of section 29 of Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960), provides that whosoever contravenes any of the provisions of sections 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 13A, 14, 18, 21 and 22 shall on conviction be punishable with fine which for a first offence, may extend to two hundred and fifty rupees and for a second 33/4618/MC.

or any subsequent offence, may extend to five hundred rupees. At a conference held by the Minister for Labour, it was suggested that for a second offence under the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, the punishment of imprisonment should be given. In order to give effect to the said suggestion, it is proposed to amend the said Act suitably.

2. The Bill is intended to achieve the above object.

The Bill, if enacted and brought into operation, would not involve any expenditure from the Consolidated Fund of the State.
